

CHIP IN Rules for LGA

This activity is optional. However, you have to be in it to win it! The cost to participate is \$1.

In order to clearly define which players are eligible for a payout for a CHIP IN during an LGA event the following policies have been put into place:

1. A player must donate \$1 prior to the round and print their name on the Chip In sign in sheet. Players should make every effort to use \$1 bills. \$10's and \$20's are not allowed. Players should not use coins for the fund either.
2. When a player achieves a CHIP IN during the round they MUST report the CHIP IN immediately following their round. There will be a sign in sheet in the lunch area.
3. Once all teams have returned to the club house and the Pro has announced the winners, the CHIP IN sheet will close and the monies will be awarded to the winners.
4. If a player fails/forgets to record their CHIP IN by the time the Pro announces game winners, they are no longer eligible for a payout.
5. Players who leave the facility after the round must ensure their CHIP IN is recorded and their monies will be held until their next attendance at LGA.
6. During SCRAMBLE events there will be no CHIP IN competitions.

Valid CHIP IN: Player hits a ball from the collar of the green and the ball is holed.

Valid CHIP IN: Player hits a ball from 100 yards and the ball rolls onto the green and into the hole.

Valid CHIP IN: Player tees off on a Par 3 and gets a Hole In One! Also counts as a CHIP IN.

Valid CHIP IN: Player A is on the collar of the green and putts the ball down the hill. It rolls off the green onto the other side with no intent by the player to do so. Player A has never established an "at rest" ball on the green and is therefore still eligible for a CHIP IN.

Not a CHIP IN: Player A hits their ball onto the green. They then putt the ball and it rolls off the green. They are no longer eligible for a CHIP IN on that hole.

Not a CHIP IN: Player A is on the collar of the green and purposely putts off the other side of the green to obtain a better opportunity to get a CHIP IN. Player A is no longer eligible for a CHIP IN. (This behavior would be seriously frowned upon.)
