

## **LGA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT** **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Must be an 18-hole LGA member at time of sign-up. Participants may be V or VI tees in this two-day cumulative tournament at two separate courses. Flights will be separated by index. Players must play both days in order to qualify for prizes.

### **TOURNAMENT FEES**

There will be a \$10 participation fee for this two-day event.

### **SCHEDULE**

The tournament is played on 2 consecutive LGA days at different courses. No alternate game with a payout will be provided.

### **FORMAT**

This is an Individual two-day stroke play event. Participant's gross and net scores from day 1 will be added to day 2 for the two day cumulative Gross and Net total.

### **PAIRINGS**

Pairings by handicap within flights for the 1st day and then by scores on the final day. Flights will be evenly divided based on number of participants and their handicaps. VI tee flight will be created only if 12 or more members participate on day 1 of the tournament.

### **HANDICAP**

95% allowance, as determined by the World Handicap System, will be printed on official score cards prepared by the Tournament Director.

### **RULES**

The USGA Rules of Golf will prevail, except where modified by "Local Rules" of The Clubs at St. James and the LGA. A 12 stroke maximum score will be in effect and designated by marking an x12 on the score card and especially in Ghin. Also, special instructions may be announced as needed by the Tournament Director.

### **TIE-BREAKING**

In the event of a tie for Overall Gross, then playoff holes will begin on the course until a winner is established. All other ties within the flights will be decided by a USGA scorecard playoff, back nine, last six, last three, last one.

### **CONDITIONS OF PLAY, TIMING OF THE ROUND AND RAIN DATES**

Will be determined in advance by the Committee in charge of the event and written and/or announced before play as needed.

### **AWARDS**

Overall Low Gross awarded for the V flight only and overall Low Net awarded for V and VI flights. Then, Gross and Net prizes will be awarded dependent on flights created. The overall winners will also have their names placed on the LGA Tournament Plaque.
