

# LGA QUEEN OF CLUBS TOURNAMENT

## FORMAT

The event is an individual four-day stroke play competition, one at each course. Players may compete from either V or VI tees in this four-day cumulative tournament. Flights will be separated by index. Participants are *required* to play all four days to qualify for overall Gross and Net prizes. Participants' gross and net scores from all four days to determine the four-day cumulative Gross and Net total.

## SCHEDULE

The tournament will take place over four consecutive LGA days across our four courses. Should space permit, individuals who are not participating in the tournament may also play. Please note that there will be no alternate game or payout during the tournament period.

## ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the LGA Queen of Clubs Tournament, individuals must be 18-hole LGA members at the time of sign-up.

## TOURNAMENT FEES

A \$5 participation fee is required for each day of this four-day event.

## AWARDS

Participants who compete across all four days will be eligible for the Overall Low Gross award in the V flight, while the Overall Low Net award will be presented for the combined V and VI flights. Additional Gross and Net prizes will be distributed according to the flights established for the tournament.

Each day of the tournament, all flights will be awarded Gross and Net prizes for the play day.

The names of the overall winners will be placed on the LGA Tournament Plaque.

## PAIRINGS

Pairings for the first day will be made by handicap within flights. Flights will be evenly divided based on the number of participants and their handicaps. Tournament Participants will remain in the flights they were assigned to on the first day of the tournament. A VI tee flight will only be created if 12 or more members participate on day one of the tournament.

## HANDICAP

A 100% handicap allowance, as determined by the World Handicap System, will be applied. The adjusted handicaps will be printed on official score cards prepared by the Tournament Director.

## RULES

The USGA Rules of Golf will govern the tournament, except where modified by the Local Rules of The Clubs at St. James and the LGA. A 12-stroke maximum score per hole will be in effect, indicated by marking an "x12" on the score card. Additional instructions may be announced as needed by the Tournament Director.

### **PACE OF PLAY**

The Professional Staff will monitor Pace of play. You will be expected to keep up with the group in front of you.

### **TIE-BREAKING**

If there is a tie for Overall Gross, playoff holes will be played on the course until a winner is determined. All other ties within flights will be decided using a USGA scorecard playoff, starting with the back nine, then the last six, last three, and finally the last one.

### **CONDITIONS OF PLAY, TIMING OF THE ROUND AND RAIN DATES**

Conditions of play, timing of the round, and rain dates will be determined in advance by the Committee in charge of the event. These details will be provided in writing and/or announced before play as needed.
