

LGA RINGER TOURNAMENT

FORMAT

This competition consists of an individual, two-day stroke play format held at the same course. Each participant's final Gross and Net scores will be determined by their best score on each hole across both days. Round 1 scores will be posted to GHIN for all players. Round 2 will not be posted as you are encouraged to pick up if you can't improve on the Round 1 Gross score. You must play both days to qualify. Flights will be structured according to player index. Completion of each hole is required for the score to be included.

SCHEDULE

The tournament will be played on two consecutive LGA days at the same course. There will not be an alternate game with a payout during the tournament.

ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the LGA Ringer Tournament, individuals must be 18-hole LGA members at the time of sign-up.

TOURNAMENT FEES

A \$10 participation fee is required for this two-day event.

AWARDS

An award for Overall Low Gross will be given for the V flight only, and an award for Overall Low Net will be presented for the V and VI flights. Additional Gross and Net prizes will be awarded based on the flights created during the tournament. The names of the overall winners will be placed on the LGA Tournament Plaque.

PAIRINGS

Pairings for the first day will be made by handicap within flights. On the final day, pairings will be determined by scores. Flights will be evenly divided based on the number of participants and their handicaps. A VI tee flight will only be created if 12 or more members participate on day one of the tournament.

HANDICAP

A 100% handicap allowance, as determined by the World Handicap System, will be applied. The adjusted handicaps will be printed on official score cards prepared by the Tournament Director.

RULES

The USGA Rules of Golf will govern the tournament, except where modified by the Local Rules of The Clubs at St. James and the LGA. A 12-stroke maximum score per hole will be in effect, indicated by marking an "x12" on the score card. Additional

instructions may be announced as needed by the Tournament Director.

PACE OF PLAY

The Professional Staff will monitor Pace of play. You will be expected to keep up with the group in front of you.

On the second day, if you are unable to improve upon your score from the first day for a given hole, you are permitted to pick up and proceed to the next hole to maintain an appropriate pace of play.

TIE-BREAKING

If there is a tie for Overall Gross, playoff holes will be played on the course until a winner is determined. All other ties within flights will be decided using a USGA scorecard playoff, starting with the back nine, then the last six, last three, and finally the last one.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY, TIMING OF THE ROUND AND RAIN DATES

Conditions of play, timing of the round, and rain dates will be determined in advance by the Committee in charge of the event. These details will be provided in writing and/or announced before play as needed.
